NB: A team sponsorship may consist of either goods or services which a sponsor makes available to the local Team Rynkeby team. The team sponsorship can also be given in cash to cover some of the costs incurred by the local Team Rynkeby team in connection with the trip to Paris or other activities. This may include costs for fuel, food, purchase of radio equipment or other necessities for which the local team cannot get sponsorship. The cash contribution will therefore not go to one of the organisations that Team Rynkeby Foundation partners with.

Switzerland and Belgium. The charity work rounds off with a cycling trip to Paris in July, and in September, all the funds raised are presented to the organisations that Team Rynkeby Foundation works with.

All participants on Team Rynkeby cover their own expenses for a bike, bike clothing and hotel costs (but may have team sponsors to cover for fuel for follow cars, ferry costs and training weekends etc.). The central costs of the project are equally covered by Eckes-Granini – through its brands Rynkeby, God Morgon, Hohes C and Greanini – and the different organizations that receive money.

The funds raised are donated to the organisation that Team Rynkeby Foundation works with in the country in which this Agreement is concluded.

4. Rights and responsibilities between the parties:

The Sponsor pays the amount or makes available the goods or services stipulated in the section 'The agreed sponsorship'.

Where the Agreement involves a cash sponsorship, payment must be made in accordance with the payment terms set out in the invoice sent under separate cover. Where the Agreement involves a provisions sponsorship, the Sponsor must provide the agreed goods or services in accordance with a separately agreed schedule. Where the Agreement involves a loan, Team Rynkeby undertakes to return the products within the agreed deadline.

It is the Sponsor's responsibility to provide the materials that will enable Team Rynkeby to meet its commitments in respect of 'Visibility'.

Team Rynkeby Foundation grants the Sponsor the right to use Team Rynkeby's name, logo, banners and graphic elements in the Sponsor's own marketing as per the guidelines under the 'Visibility' section. All materials can be downloaded from Team Rynkeby's website.



5. The agreed sponsorship:

The Sponsorship Agreement between Team Rynkeby and the Sponsor comprises the following sponsorship (tick)

Provisions team sponsorship (*donations of relevant goods, products and services, etc.*)

Cash team sponsorship (*cash sponsor of min. DKK 3,500 (Denmark), SEK 5,000 (Sweden), NOK 5,000 (Norway), €500 (Finland), DKK 3,500 (the Faroe Islands), ISK 50,000 (Iceland), €500 (Germany), CHF 1,000 (Switzerland), €500 (Belgium) excl. VAT*)

While the website does contain information about Team Rynkeby’s intended races, these intended races shall not be considered obligations of Team Rynkeby. Especially in case of, but not limited to events of force majeure, including epidemic and pandemic outbreaks, which shall include but not be limited to the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak, Team Rynkeby may not in the sole opinion of Team Rynkeby be able to organize the intended races. If these situations, Team Rynkeby will strive to organize at least one national race for each Team Rynkeby Team if considered safe and possible in the sole opinion of Team Rynkeby. Under no circumstances whatsoever and howsoever shall Team Rynkeby in such situations be liable to the Sponsor for any kind of losses, delays, liabilities, claims, non-performance or other effects of whatsoever kind being a direct or indirect result of such changes in or cancellations of the intended race program and the Sponsor further accepts that the Sponsor will not ask for, and cannot be, in any way reimbursed their sponsoring amount due to any cancellations of or changes in the intended race program.

The sponsorship amount must be specified in DKK, SEK, NOK, Euro, ISK or CHF excluding VAT

VAT must be added to all cash sponsorships.



6. Visibility

The sponsor will receive visibility on Team Rynkeby's website etc. as agreed below:

7. The period of validity

Once the signed Sponsorship Agreement has been set up in Team Rynkeby Foundation's system, it will be forwarded electronically to the Sponsor for approval. The Agreement enters into force once the Agreement has been approved electronically. Team Rynkeby Foundation will send an invoice to the Sponsor once the Agreement has been approved electronically. All sponsorship agreements expire on 31/08/2022.

This Agreement may be terminated with immediate effect in the event of substantial breach of contract by either party. Significant delay in the payment of the sponsorship amount or the provision of other services, as well as acts by or the behaviour of either party which, objectively, are contrary to generally accepted good practice or the law, or otherwise cause harm to the other party's reputation are always considered as substantial breach. Any dispute regarding the sponsorship contract, including disputes regarding the existence or validity of the sponsorship contract, must be settled in accordance with Danish law with the Court in Svendborg as the first instance.

Upon termination/expiry of the Agreement, the parties remove the other party's name, logo and other symbols possibly allowed from their material and website, as well as from other such publications and contexts in which the other party's name, logo or other symbols are used.
