This is where all the 68 Team Rynkeby teams arrive after spending a week on the road, making their way through Europe to Paris.

We are so honored that you will be there to help us welcome – and celebrate – both riders and service crew.

It all takes place at Vélodrome Jacques Anquetil July 12th 2025. You will find the programme of the day, just a few pages on.

There are two ways to get there with public transportation (see figure 1):

- 1. Take the metro 8 to Liberté, walk approx. 530 m to Vélodrome Jacques Anquetil
- 2. Bus 77 to Gravelle Jaurès, which is right in front of the main entrance (Payment cash)

Please use the old entrance (just after the bus stop).

Mobile toilets are available throughout the area.

Please notice:

- The Velodrome is a smoke-free area.
- Barbecuing on the premises is strictly prohibited.








RaceMap (GPS Tracking)

The Racemap is ready for download in app store or Google Play


Search for TourDeParis and you will find the app

Select Team Rynkeby 2025 Ride.. Click on "Map"






RaceMap (GPS Tracking)

Team Rynkeby – A European Charity Projekt

Since 2002, Team Rynkeby has raised over **100 million euros** for children with critical illnesses and their families.

What started as a small Danish cycling team has grown into an international movement with **67 local teams** plus one international team across **eight countries**.

Each year, our participants, riders & service, embark on the Tour de Paris to mark the conclusion of an intense fundraising period. The funds come from **sponsorships**, **events**, **school runs**, **and the sale of various products**, with volunteers contributing to the cause.

The grand finale takes place in Paris, where all teams gather to celebrate their efforts and the shared mission of making a difference – and we are happy that you are joining the celebrations!



About the Vélodrome

Build in 1894, making it one of the oldest velodromes in the world.

Originally known as the Vélodrome de Vincennes, but today know as Vélodrome Jacques Anquetil, after the first cyclist to win the Tour de France five times.

Hosted the Olympics as main stadium in 1900 as well as Olympic cycle stadium 1924.

Hosted the finish of the Tour de France each year between 1968 and 1974.

And now, of course, hosted the Team Rynkeby arrival in Paris 2024 and 2025.
